- Closing date for entries is June 10, 2012. There will be no entries accepted on the field
- Bands traveling 100+ miles, who participate in closing mass bands, as well as compete, will receive \$100 travel money
- With the exception of band and quartet grading, the rules of The BC Pipers Association will be applied. Any challenge or protest to procedures or scoring must be submitted in writing on the day of the games.
